
Replacement of the Contact Point



You need the following tools to change a contact point like an expert: Flat pliers (A) a piece of leather or felt (B), and the contact point.




To avoid a damage of the rack, it first has to be pushed to the end position. Keep the rack in this position.



While keeping the rack in end position, the contact point is detached by using the leather or felt and the flat pliers by screwing anti-clockwise.



After loosening, the contact point may be removed manually out of the rack.



The new contact point has to be screwed clockwise into the rack.



Now the rack has to be pushed again to the end position.

The contact point now has to be tightened by using the leather or felt and the flat pliers.



The contact point now was changed in the right way and without any damage of the rack. You may use the dial gauge again in an optimal way.
